## **NO CELL PHONES – Newport CC Rule**

Tees: Play will be from the RED Markers. Seniors playing forward – WHITE Markers

French Drains: are to be treated as obstructions; proceed under Rule 16.1.

<u>Out of Bounds</u>: A ball which crosses a public road is classified as out of bounds. If a ball crosses a public road and comes to rest on another part of the course beyond the road it is deemed to be out of bounds.

<u>Boundary</u>: #2 Edge of paved public road (golf course side) is deemed to be course boundary; #3-5 chain link fence poles (+ chicken wire on #3). Hole #8 & 11 white stakes and painted white line. Holes #10, 11 & 16 stone wall (ball is OB when it comes to rest over the wall).

**Hole #16**: Ball drop area short and left of the green is provided as an additional option for a ball that comes to rest in the lateral penalty area that surrounds the green.

<u>**Play-off**</u>: In the event of a tie after the completion of all scheduled play, there will be a sudden death playoff to determine a winner. Should there be a tie for the Senior Division, the playoff will be contested from the forward tees regardless of the tees played during the championship.
